**ATTENTION NEW PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS:  
DRIVER'S LICENSE, AUTO REGISTRATION AND  
AUTO INSURANCE INFORMATION**

You must obtain a Pennsylvania driver's license within 60 days after moving to the state. To obtain a driver's license, you must present a valid out of state driver's license or birth certificate and your social security card.

To obtain a Pennsylvania registration and license plate, you must present your title or registration and proof of insurance to a local notary or agency such as AAA\*. All motor vehicles registered and operating in Pennsylvania must be covered by a standard automobile liability policy from an insurance company licensed to do business in the Commonwealth. You must obtain coverage in order to retain your registration privilege.

You can also apply for your voter's registration card at the time you get your driver's license.
